




Ohio's smoking ban takes effect on Thursday, December 7, 2006. To comply with this new law post the attached or similar sign at the entrance to enclosed areas at your facility.

These are not the only signs that meet the statute, but are sample signs that, when properly placed, meet the requirements.

Please note: If the no smoking symbol () is used, it must, in accordance with ORC 3794.06A be printed in color.
